Home on the brink of closure

A cash strapped non-governmental and non-profit organisation is threading in deep waters, unless the institution receives a capital injection to save it from closing its doors.

The Merewent Cheshire Home which has been operational for the past 22 years and caters for the largest number of people with physical disabilities in KwaZulu-Natal, could be shutting down doors as the funds they have will only last for a few months causing the facility to shut down in July 2017.

Speaking to the Rising Sun Newspaper, manager of the home for the past 22 years, Sharita Bundhu, shared the challenges they have been experiencing. "We are in a dire state at the moment. If we do not generate enough funds, many of the people who are living here will have no where to stay. There are no other residential homes that we can transfer our residents to and a number of our residents do not have families and even if they do, the infrastructure is not safe or wheelchair friendly. We are in a serious dilemma as our deficit for the month is between R25, 000 and R45, 000, with only a reserve to last us for the next 10

months. We have tried fundraising but it is just not enough. We lack the manpower due to limited resources, volunteer support and many adverse factors such as the stress on the economic climate of the country. We are urgently seeking the assistance of the public and businesses to come forward and assist us so we can assist those in need. We need funds to be able to buy food, toiletries and other essential items to sustain our residents. We also lack volunteers who will be able to come in and help assist us." Man beaten to death with wheel jack

A 27-year-old Bluff resident lost his life after he sustained blunt force trauma injuries to his head during an assault in the Brighton Beach policing area, recently.

The deceased was believed to have been socialising at a local place of entertainment with a group of people. As the evening drew to a close, the deceased, together with two men from the group of seven, decided to go for a swim at Anstey's Beach, while three women and another man in the group remained in their vehicle.

The main accused took a jack from the stationary vehicle and chased after the deceased. With one swing of the jack, the deceased was struck across his head. It is further alleged that the main accused continued to punch the deceased several times in the face. One of the woman in the group pulled the accused off the deceased and placed the deceased on his side as he was choking on his own blood. The group then fled the scene.

Brighton Beach SAPS communications officer, Cpt

Louise Le Roux said, "A good Samaritan removed the man from the scene and took him to a local hospital hoping to save him, but he was declared dead on ar-

rival. The accused were traced through the number plate of the vehicle they used, which was visible on a short video clip that was released into evidence."

Lead detective, W/O Gerhard Grobler from the Brighton Beach Detective Services, contacted the owner, which in turn led to tracing the group. The two men, aged 16 and 25, were charged with premeditated murder. The pair appeared in the Durban Regional Court. The 25-year-old accused received R5000 bail whilst the 16-year-old juvenile

was released into his parents custody. The murder weapon was recovered, including the blood stained clothing from the main accused.

Brighton Beach SAPS management thanked the witnesses who came forward and made statements, including the individual that

availed the short DVD which was an instrumental piece of evidence in the investigation.

It is alleged that after their swim, there was an argument between the men about the purchasing of banned substances. The group were angry with the deceased and his friend and left them at the beach.

The group then proceeded to a 24 hour drive-through to purchase food. While placing their food order, the deceased arrived with his friend. An argument erupted between the deceased and one of the accused, which resulted in the deceased punching him in the face.

SDCEA lobbies for 24-hour asthma and cancer clinic

The South Durban Community Environmental Alliance (SDCEA) hosted a cancer seminar to create awareness, develop a healthy lifestyle and a sustainable campaign to lobby for a 24-hour asthma and cancer clinic in south Durban. The event included speakers from CANSA, the UKZN Occupational Health and the Environmental Department and had testimonies from a cancer patient and survivors. Dumisane Mvuyane of CANSA said, "We all have cancer cells in our blood and body. Cancer should not be viewed as a curse or punishment. It is for this reason that we all

should go for screening because the cancer cells are not easily identified. We should not wait till we are sick and at late stages of the disease. It's important to lead a healthy lifestyle which includes exercising and eating healthy. Prevention is better than cure." According to Nkosana Jafta of UKZN Occupational Health, 90 percent of cancers are caused by the environment and 10 percent is heredity. "The south Durban communities are subjected to many pollutants which are carcinogens and lead to cancer. It is important to have a cancer registry. I collect cancer registries from dif-

ferent provinces which are used to determine which areas have the most cancer cases and what types of cancer in those provinces," he said. The awareness and knowledge of prevention was well received. Merbank resident, Daya Naicker, who is fighting prostate cancer created awareness on the disease. He leads a healthy lifestyle by exercising on a daily basis. Naicker said you don't need to go to the gym to exercise, you can exercise at home like he does. He also checks his pH levels every morning at 6am and this is a routine he learnt through research as cancer cells love an

acidic body. Desire Bowes of Wentworth was diagnosed with ovarian cancer at the age of 25.

She has been cancer free for 25 years and is thankful for her mother's support through her dark times.

She wishes for everyone to know that cancer doesn't always mean death. If you have a positive mind

and support system you can beat cancer like she did. Desmond D'sa stressed that there is a

linkage between the chemicals in south Durban and high cancer levels with many people who work in the industry. He stated that people are dying at asbestos factories and chemical industries. SDCEA would like to encourage everyone to be part of the cancer campaign where they encourage cancer patients and survivors to sign a cancer registry. SDCEA will be hosting a cancer walk on November 18 to campaign for a 24-hour asthma and cancer clinic in south Durban. The organisation has also established a cancer support group in south Durban communities and urges members of the community to take part in the cancer campaign and inform others about the cancer registry. Detective secures murder and robbery convictions

A murder accused and robbery suspect received hefty sentences after Isipingo SAPS detective, Det/Cnst Themba Shabalala, secured the convictions, recently. In the first case, earlier this year, Isipingo police received a complaint of murder at Road 3 in Malukazi. When members arrived, they noticed a 32-year-old woman lying on a bed in a pool of blood. She was found with stab wounds to her neck, back and head. The murder weapon, an Okapi knife, was found on the floor next to the bed. The case was investigated by Det/Cnst Shabalala. On the same day, police arrested 33-year-old Sibongile Dingiwe for the murder. He was charged and appeared in the Durban Regional Court last week, where he was found guilty of murder and sentenced to 10 years imprisonment.

In the second case, during the month of October 2015, the Isipingo CBD was plagued with robberies. The modus operandi was to identify the victim, wield a knife and rob the person of cash and belongings. In the first robbery, the complainant was walking along Jadwats Street when he was surrounded by three men wielding knives. They threatened him and robbed him of R400 in cash and a cellphone. A few days later, another complainant was walking on the same street and was robbed of R1000 in cash and a cellphone valued at R3000. "During the investigations, it was revealed that the descriptions and the method used in the robberies were the same. Working on information, Det/Cnst Shabalala arrested two suspects and linked them to other

cases. Mthobisi Ngidi, 21, of Malukazi, and Mhlaba Cele, 22, of Umbumbulu, were linked to both cases and appeared in the Durban Regional Court last week on charges of robbery with a knife.

They were both found guilty and sentenced to eight years imprisonment on each case, but the sentences were to run concurrently. Two more suspects were arrested. They were found guilty and sentenced to five years each," said Isipingo SAPS communications officer, Cpt David Ragavan. The management of Isipingo SAPS would like to thank Det/Cnst Themba Shabalala for his commitment to ensuring that these suspects were removed off our streets and his resourcefulness in linking these suspects to other cases.

South Africa's tertiary institutions have seen a spate of student protests which have resulted in major disruptions and malicious damage to state property. Students are demanding complete revolutionary transformation of fee structures to free education. Candice George of the Rising Sun took to the streets to speak to students to find out their views on the current topic.

Aaliya Essop, 19, of DUT, said, "I think that the fees are high, but usually anything of quality comes at a high cost. Though constant increases isn't exactly feasible for us. We need to find a common ground, rather than making tertiary education free."

Human Resource student, 19, Utira Mocktar said, "Coming from a background and society where education is our main road to success, we should not be complaining about the fees being too high as building your future comes with a price. There are variety of financial aids available to many students across the country. As a result of the strikes, it has caused a lack of

communication of course material, resulting in confusion and frustration."

Keenan Jogiah, 19, who is studying Chemical Engineering said, "I feel that the students are fighting for a good cause as there are people who deserve to study but can't because of finances. However, I don't think that free education is possible right now so disrupting classes at this stage will do nothing but damage our chances of completing our studies."

Twenty-year-old, Warren Chetty of Merbank said, "With the high university fees it puts pressure on my parents to have to meet the deadline. I think that fees should fall so that we can spend more time focusing on studies than meeting deadlines. The violent protests have affected students as it was done during test weeks and exams."

Dinesh Ramsamy, 19, of Merbank, said "From my point of view, the fees are reasonable. How else will an institution be able to run with no finance? But I do think that they should accommodate students who don't have the fi-

nance."

Nineteen-year-old Fatima Ally said, "The fees are quite high at DUT. Students find studying very expensive as the tuition fees are sometimes paid with bursaries, but the extra cost comes from transport, food, textbooks, etc. I am sure students will be a lot happier with free education."

Trivolin Govender, 19, said, "I believe that the fees for my course are reasonable as in not too high. I believe that if the 'fees must fall' campaign succeeds, the services that DUT offers will be compromised."

Chantel Jogiah, 19, who is studying to be a teacher, said, "Personally, I think that the fees for my for my course is not that expensive after all studying towards your career comes with sacrifice and there are bursaries for students who have no finance to study. The strikes are affecting lots of students but mainly affecting their opportunity to become successful in their future careers. We need to come to an agreement where everyone can benefit."

Mercedes-Benz CLA 200 auto

Sweet, swoopy little sedan

An artful little nip 'n tuck can make a world of difference - notably in the case of the Mercedes CLA which recently had a mid-life facelift.

This A-Class based sedan is now a more compelling and engaging machine than I recall from a couple of years ago, even though the changes have been fairly mild. They number, among other things, a diamond radiator grille in black as standard, rather tasty new alloy wheels, plus some interior upgrades.

And while the suspension doesn't appear to have been fettled, it's less harsh-riding than I remember from before - a complaint I've had with some of Merc's compact cars including the A-Class and the GLA, which is really just the SUV version of the former. But I do understand the rationale for dialling into these cars a rigid ride which is meant to be perceived as sporty. With its compact cars Mercedes is appealing to a whole new generation, and they've been pretty successful. In Europe, at least the average age of drivers of these cars is around 13 years younger than for the rest of the Benz line-up.

Under the hood, if you'll pardon the Americanism, things stay pretty much the same on



this little sedan whose styling so clearly reflects its much bigger, much more expensive CLS stablemate. Pretty much the same, that is, expect for the addition of the new CLA 200d derivative to the range. This uses a version of Merc's 2 143cc turbodiesel detuned to make 100kW and

300Nm. Claimed fuel consumption is 4,4l/100km. At least that's according to controlled NEDC testing. As with most of these figures it's a case of good luck in achieving them in real-world driving. You won't.

I digress. I've just spent a week with the entry-level CLA

200, or at least one up from the entry-level as the model I had was the auto version, fitted with Mercedes' well-known seven-speed self-shifter.

Performance from this turbo-petrol 1 595cc motor - despite what the badge says it's a 1,6-litre as the days when nomen-

clature corresponded to engine size are long gone - is entirely acceptable.

Not once during a week that took in urban and freeway use did I feel the need for more than the 115kW and 250Nm at 1,250 to 4,000rpm generated by this motor. This corresponds

to a zero-to-100km/h time of 8.2 seconds, and a top speed of 230km/h. Which of course is almost double the legal limit, and so totally needless.

Drive is to the front wheels, as it is with the rest of the range, bar the halo model in the lineup, the Mercedes-AMG CLA 45 4Matic, while claimed fuel consumption is 5,5l/100km.

Cutting to the interior, well, as it's as ergonomically excellent and attractive as all modern Merc interiors, and well-specified too. But as with most of this Swabian manufacturer's cars - and indeed most German cars - there is a vast and expensive list of optional extras to select from. Go really wild in specifying these, and adding around the half the purchase price of the car itself in optional extras is not beyond the realms of possibility.

For this sweet little sedan you'll pay R482,712. But - and this is a big "but" - you'd arguably be better off paying only fractionally more and getting an entry-level C-Class. You see, while this facelift has convincingly polished the CLA, the slightly larger C-Class embodies better perceived quality, and a calming, balm ride that this car, improved as it is, still lacks. Then again the CLA is a more extroverted, youthful beast, so I guess you pay your money and take your choice.

million rand Volvo XC90 T5 R-Design Geartronic, to give it its full name, and found that the interior was a joke, filled with

baubles and gimmicks aimed at amusing the teenagers who marketing folk target at the exclusion of all else these days, I'd have been more than a little put out.

Not as much as if it were my million rand, of course, but I'd have still been annoyed on behalf of all the over 40s out there.

The interior is superb, as is usual with Volvo, well sculpt-

ed, refined and bereft of bling. The controls are well laid out and uncomplicated, while the nappa leather seats and seemingly genuine aluminium trim features are as good as you'll get anywhere.

There's loads of space, it's a full seven-seater, and the luggage compartment is capacious.

This is a big, imposing and classy vehicle that has deservedly scooped 2016 Car of the Year awards around the world, including in our country.

Over the years the XC90 has been offered with a range of different four, five and six cylinder petrol and diesel engines. For this model, launched last year, they've moved with the times and opted for just a single two-litre four-cylinder motor available in petrol or diesel, tuned to produce between 140 and 235kW, depending on how much you want to spend and how fast you want to go. The

test car was a T5 version with a turbocharged petrol motor that puts out a respectable 187kW and 350Nm of torque at 1500rpm.

Thinking subjectively, I'd rather have a five or six cylinder motor because the four can sound a little unrefined at lower speeds, but the engine does the job well without any fuss. It's good for a claimed 230km/h top end and the 100km/h mark comes up in around 8.5 seconds so you never feel like you've been short-changed once you get on the road.

As with the rest of the range

the XC90 T5 comes with an efficient eight-speed auto transmission delivering drive to all four wheels. There are four drive modes - Eco, Comfort, Dynamic and Off Road, and the big wagon is loaded to the brim with electronic safety and driver aids as standard. The car we got has a base price of R926,900 but carried another R93,950 worth of non-essential options. A fair chunk of that was R19,750 for a set of impractical 22" wheels, which I'd forsake even for free because they reduce practicality. And the Volvo XC90 T5 is about as practical as you'll get.
